What's happening in Class

In reading, we've been reading non-fiction, narrative, and folktales about earthquakes, and finding commonalities and differences. Our Persuasive Writing unit continues. Most kids have completed one piece already, and are working on another. We've been focused on using hooks to engage the reader, and conclusions that urge the audience to action. In Math, we're into our second unit on Fractions. We've been working on comparing fractions by finding a common denominator. The next unit will be on Geometry. In Science, we're starting our unit on Earth, Sun, and moon, and how they relate to day/night, seasons, and moon phases. We will finish the year with a unit on Energy Transfer, which will conclude with our Lighthouse Café, on June 8.
