What's happening in Class

I'm wrapping up my testing of kids' reading comprehension, fluency, accuracy, and ability to retell the story. In reading, we've been working on comprehension strategies, vocabulary, and grammar, including common \$ proper nouns, adverbs, and pronouns. In Spelling, kids have completed the second sort for their level, and will be bringing home another list on Monday. Our unit on writing realistic fiction narratives continues with a focus on using **sensory details** to help readers make a **mind movie** of the action, as well as showing characters' motivation and struggles in each scene. In Math, we're completed out unit on place value. comparing numbers, rounding, regrouping, and ungrouping with an assessment next week. Next, we'll be looking at **multiplication** with 1, 2, and 3 digit numbers. Our Social Studies unit on **Geography** is wrapping up next week with an assessment on locating the U.S, and comparing the **Midwest region**, to another we've been working on. We'll be starting our unit on plants and animals for our first unit in **Science** in the next.
