What's happening in Class

In reading, we've completed our first module in the new reading series featuring a narrative, biography, and non-fiction piece about scientists. We've been working on using quotation marks correctly in our writing, and identifying fragments, and run-on sentences. Kids continue to work on strategies for **Spelling**. In writing, we're wrapping up our study of **realistic fiction**. We've talked about using memorable endings, and will be putting the finishing touches on our work next week. In Math, we're still working on multiplication with 1, 2, and 3 digit numbers. We've got another week or two before we take the unit test, and move on to division. Our Science unit on plants and animals is wrapping up in another week or so with a look at food webs, and how plants and animals depend on each other, and how small changes in ecosystems can have huge impacts.
