### What's happening in Class

Our third grade team is focusing on strengthening the **comprehension** of students through small group instruction, and introduction of strategies to help struggling readers. Our strategies are designed to help with comprehension, accuracy, fluency, and expanding vocabulary. In grammar, we continue to work on singular, plural, singular possessive and plural possessives this week. In **Spelling**, we've been working on adding suffixes, and revisiting some concepts we touched on earlier in the year. We're finishing up our third writing unit as we prepare for our assessment on personal essays. We have been working on weaving our "big ideas" throughout essays about doing the right thing, accepting change, helping in small ways, and giving people a chance. Our Math unit on measurement is well under way. We have been learning the standard and metric units of measurement for weight, length, and volume. We'll also be telling time to the nearest minute, and working on solving problems with elapsed time. In Social Studies, we have been learning about the early history of MI. After break, we will be tackling another 2 units in Science. Kids will be learning about force and motion.
