Michigan History Museum Project

We're asking the students to learn even more about Michigan history. Third graders at Quincy will be hosting a *Michigan Museum* where your child will share the information they've learned about the Michigan *person* or *feature* that he/she has chosen and researched. Presentations will be focused on the **historic** and/or **economic** impact to MI. We will be inviting parents, guests, and other classrooms in the school to come and visit our living Michigan History Museum. Visitors to the museum will listen as your child recites a script summarizing what they've learned about their person or topic.

This year, kids will be doing the *research* and script writing at school. At home, kids will be creating a visual presentation (poster, diorama, model, etc.) to go with their script. Also, we're asking kids to dress the part by wearing clothes similar to what their person would have worn, or dressing nicely to display what they've created to showcase their knowledge.
